

Apparatus - s

- *Silicon plates (4*4),
- *Erasers,
- *Insulated wires,
- *Stretchable bands.

Procedure:-

- *Cut the insulated wire into two strands (pieces) and strip the end of each wire.
- *Clean the two silicon plates with the kerosene
- *Place the 2 erasers in between the plates and tight up with the stretchable bands
- *Connect one end of 2 insulated wires

to the terminals of power supply and other to the silicon plates

*Check the connections and then the water heater is ready to use,

He was born in a poor family in Muddenahalli of Karnataka on 15-Sep-1860.

He designed automatic sluice gates which was later reused for Lake Fife and the same design was reused for Tigra Dam & KRS Dam as well. Over the next 10 years (between 1895 & 1905), Sir MV worked at different parts of India including

- •Hyderabad where he remodelled the entire city & improved its drainage system.
- •Bombay where he introduced block system of irrigation & water weir flood gates,
- •Bihar & Orissa where he was involved in building railway bridges & water supply schemes

•Mysore where he supervised the construction of KRS dam which was Asia's biggest


Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum, Bangalore (VITM), a constituent unit of National Council of Science Museums (NCSM) Ministry of Culture, Government of India, was established in memory of Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya. A modest building with a built up area of 4000 sq. mtrs., was constructed in the serene surrounding of the Cubbon Park, housing various industrial products and engines, which was opened by the first Prime Minister of India, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru on 14.07.1962. The first gallery set up at VITM on the theme 'Electricity' was opened to the public on 27.07.1965 by the then Union Minister for Information & Broadcasting & Bharat Ratna Indira Gandhi.

Science On A Sphere

It is a large visualization system that uses multimedia projections to display animated data onto the exterior of a sphere converting it into an immersive animated globe that shows dynamic, animated images of the atmosphere, oceans, and land of a planet. It adds as another education and outreach tool of this museum

Max Karl Ernst Ludwig Planck

(April 23, 1858

October 4, 1947)

Planck a German theoretical physicist born in Kiel, Germany, made many contributions to theoretical

physics, but his fame rests primarily

on his role as originator of the quantum theory. He had his early schooling in Kiel before his family moved to Munich. At school he performed well but at the same time he did not show any sign of outstanding talent. It is said that at the beginning his best subject at school was perhaps music. Planck was appointed the professor of theoretical physics at the University of Berlin. By combining the formulae of Wien and Rayleigh, he announced a new formula now known as Planck's radiation formula and was a philosopher of science. He was also awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics in 1918. Planck describes why he chose physics: "The outside world is something independent from man, something absolute, and the quest for the laws which apply to this absolute appeared to me as the most sublime scientific pursuit in life." This great man died at the age of 89 in Gottingen, West Germany and the value "h+6.62x10-27 erg.sec" is engraved on his tombstone.
