Day 1:

Day 2:

- Paragraph forming questions (Verbal)

Day 3:

- Simple interest and compound interest (Quantitative)
- Prefixes, suffixes, root word concept, misspelt words
- Session on public speaking

Day 4:

- Time and distance (Quantitative)
- Nouns, pronouns and articles (Verbal)
- Percentages

Day 5:

- Profit and loss, partnership (Quantitative)
- Grammar-verbs, adjectives, adverbs(Verbal)
- Blood relations, direction sense, symbols and notations (Logical)
