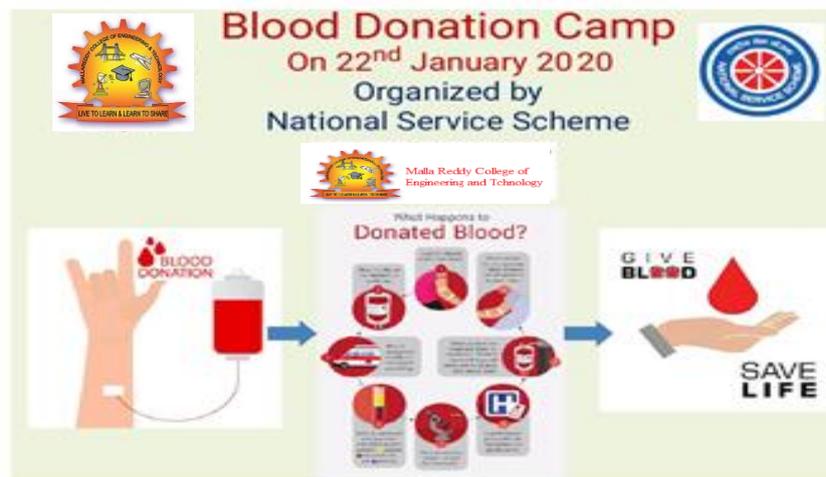
# 1. Blood donation camp

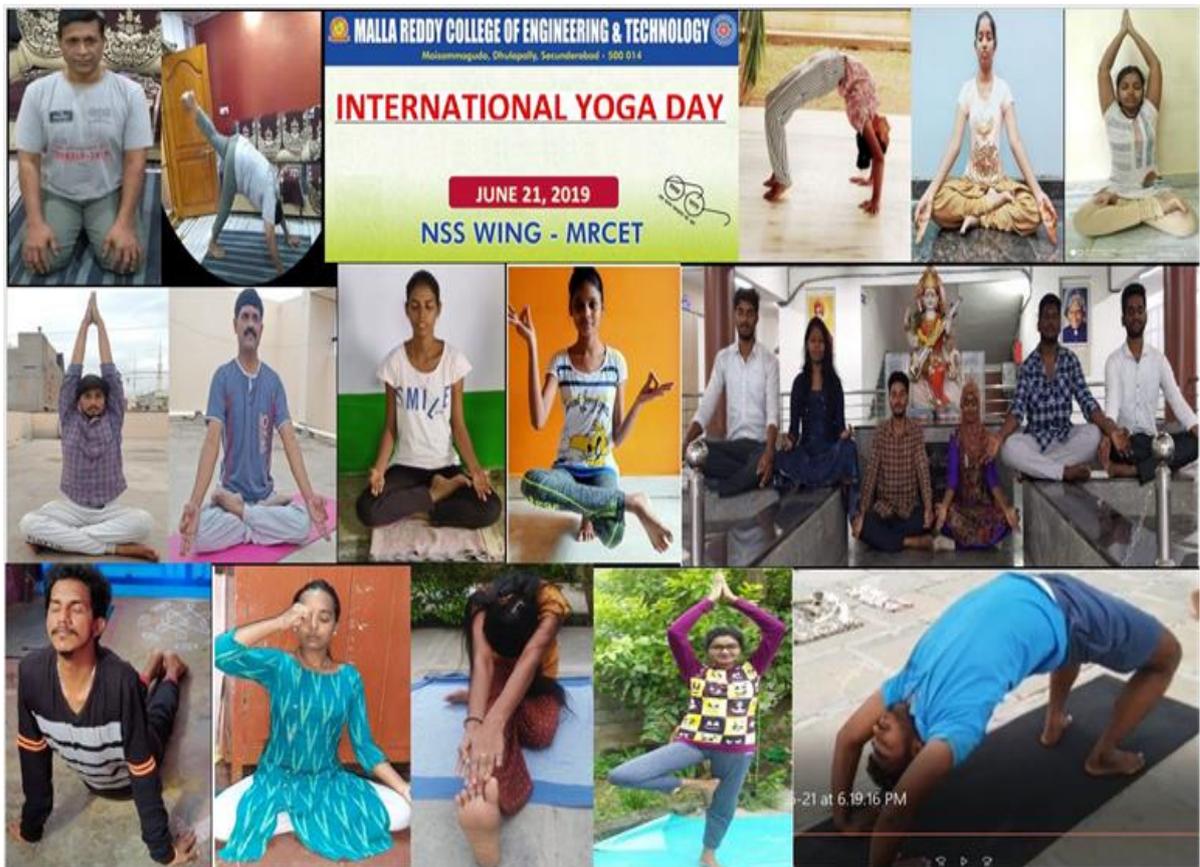
### 3. Yoga

With the help of cleanliness, we can keep our physical and mental health clean, which will make us feel good. **Cleanliness** gives rise to a good character by keeping body, mind, and soul clean and peaceful. Maintaining cleanliness is the essential part of healthy living because it is the cleanliness only which helps to improve our personality by keeping clean externally and internally.

The programs cover topics such as **environmental awareness**, criminal liability, small quantity generators, large quantity generators, and risk-management. The environmental awareness video provides insight into the EPA's rulings and trains employees to protect the environment. It includes sections of air quality, water quality, hazardous waste, and chemical safety and use. The programs explain RCRA and the mismanagement of hazardous waste, including identifying hazardous waste, transportation procedures, waste minimization programs, emergency plans, and record keeping.
