

UNDERSTANDING RULES AND REGULATIONS: A PATH TO HARMONY

Dr SS Rao, the Principal of Mallareddy College of engineering and technology (MRCET) addressed the B.Tech first year students on 31st of August, 2024 to brief the rules and regulations of the organization.

Some of the following rules were explained by the Principal:

1. Students must meet minimum attendance (75%) requirements to be promoted to the next year.
2. Misbehavior may result in disciplinary action, such as expulsion or fines.
3. Students may be required to complete a mini project.
4. The medium of instructions for the entire under graduate programme in Engineering & Technology will be English only.
5. A stipulated fee shall be payable for condoning of shortage of attendance.
6. For practical subjects there shall be a continuous internal evaluation during the semester for 40 marks and 60 marks for semester end examination.
7. A student who has obtained an 'F' grade in any subject shall be deemed to have 'failed' and is required to reappear as a 'supplementary student' in the semester end examination, as and when offered.
8. There shall be no branch transfers after the completion of admission process.
9. To be eligible for the Certificate 'C' examination, a cadet must have passed the 'B' certificate, attended at least two camps, and attended at least 75% of the periods of the third year syllabus. Eligible students are encouraged to complete NCC course.
10. One must complete B.Tech program in a minimum of four academic years and a maximum of eight academic years.
